

And Abram said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir. And, behold, the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir." Genesis 15:2-4

Seeing the Big Picture

- Man's struggle to see the big picture
- Sarai gives Hagar to Abraham assuming she would be forever childless
- *"And Sarai said unto Abram, Behold now, the LORD hath restrained me from bearing: I pray thee, go in unto my maid; it may be that I may obtain children by her. And Abram hearkened to the voice of Sarai."
 Genesis 16:2
- Seemingly the only solution

Seeing the Big Picture

- Abraham's suggestion that Ishmael be his heir
- * "And Abraham said unto God, O that Ishmael might live before thee!" Genesis 17:18
- Once gain, seemingly obvious, and simple solution

- * "And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here am I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the lamb for a burnt offering? And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together."
 Genesis 22:7-8

- Esther recognized the fate of the Jewish nation was greater than her life
- *"Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, and neither eat nor drink three days, night or day: I also and my maidens will fast likewise; and so will I go in unto the king, which is not according to the law: and if I perish, I perish."

Esther 4:16

Seeing the Big Picture

- Antipas sees the big picture
- Antipas looked beyond this life into eternity
- "I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth." Revelation 2:13

Seeing the Big Picture

"Pliny, governor of Roman province of Bithynia, stated in letter to Trajan, "he gave those who were accused an abundant opportunity of recanting; those who persisted in this faith were executed."

....Antipas persisted because he saw the big picture
